

## BLA Degree Directed Electives List

### PLANTS ELECTIVE | 3-5 CR

BLA students are required to take one additional upper division course (300-level or higher) in ecological restoration or plant management.

### ***LAND | 1 course (minimum 3 credits)***

Each student is required to take a minimum of one course in geology or earth science offered through the Earth and Space Sciences Department. This directed elective supplements but does not replace LARCH 434 Urban Soils and Hydrology. These courses have a mandatory prerequisite course: one of ESS 101, ESS 105, ESS 210, or ESS 211. BLA students typically complete this prerequisite prior to entering the program.
